


Preface





Doctors Day Celebration



The infant had respiratory distress since birth for which the parents of the infant sorted consultation in various cities. The infant was misdiagnosed as a case of pneumothorax for which multiple times ICD insertion was done. However, child didn't respond to the treatment and finally came to UPUMS Saifai. The team of Pediatrician under the guidance of Prof. Rajesh Yadav, Head of Department Pediatrics and Dr Muniba Alim, Assistant Professor, worked up the child and diagnosed the infant with CLE involving left upper lobe.

The management included exhaustive preoperative preparation, smooth induction by the expert anesthetist, strenuous operative procedure and intricate postoperative care. The team of Pediatricians and Pediatric Surgeons took the daunting task of managing the infant. The expert team of Anesthetist lead by Prof. Usha Shukla and Dr Suchi Nigam took the challenge of giving Anesthesia to infant weighing only 7 kg. Team of Pediatric Surgeons comprising of Dr Rafey A. Rahman, Dr U. K. Gupta and Dr Survesh performed the complicated surgery that lasted for 2 hours in which diseased portion of left lung was removed. Postoperative course in such children is often stormy as the patient can get complicated quickly and may require respiratory support. However, with the help of expert team of Pediatric intensivist the child was managed successfully postoperatively. The child does not need oxygen support now and has been discharged in stable state.

The constant support and guidance from the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Dr Prabhat Kumar Singh encouraged the doctors to manage and successfully treat this exceedingly challenging condition.



Singh congratulated the inventors for the noble work. The invented design is a non-invasive, ergonomically designed, handy and easy to use with better inter observer reliability. The invented design is superior to the available non-invasive techniques like Power Doppler Ultrasound. This technique will be used in screening (early detection) and monitoring treatment of RA.


Thermography is a technique that measures the temperature of affected area without physical contact by capturing the infrared radiation energy of an object using a thermographic camera. The concept of Thermal Camera is based on thermography image and digital image of the subject taken with FLIR ONE Prothermal imaging camera attached to a smartphone.







Maharani Lakshmibai Jayanti




