



Uttar Pradesh University of Medical Sciences, Saifai has created indelible mark in the research arena. Two of its faculty members, Prof. Kamla Pathak and Dr. Ankur Vaidya from Faculty of Pharmacy have been enlisted in the World top 2% Scientist list released by Stanford University, US in August 2024. The list includes database of top-cited scientists and provides standardized information on citations, h-index, co-authorship adjusted hm-index, citations to papers in different authorship positions and a composite indicator (c-score). The scientists are classified into 22 scientific fields and 174 sub-fields according to the standard Science-Metrix classification. The selection is based on the top 100,000 scientists by c-score (with and without self-citations) or a percentile rank of 2% or above in the sub-field. Prof Kamla Pathak has been consecutively enlisted for the fifth time in the World top 2% Scientist List; and Dr. Ankur Vaidya got enlisted for the first time. Prof Kamla Pathak has published 332 research publications and Dr. Ankur Vaidya published 70 research publications. The key research area of Prof Kamla Pathak is novel modulated and targeted drug delivery systems delivery and has received many professional awards. The key research area of Dr. Ankur Vaidya is Cancer and drug discovery. Dr Ankur Vaidya has published 4 international books and also received Best Teacher Award-2020 (Pharmacy) by Dr. A.P.J., Abdul Kalam Technical University, Uttar Pradesh, Lucknow. Noteworthy publications of these researchers have contributed in placement of Faculty of Pharmacy, UPUMS Saifai in the NIRF ranking in 2023 and 2024.
