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General Information

Atal Bihari Vajpayee Medical University, UP, Lucknow (ABVMU) is conducting the Counselling for admission to Allied & Healthcare Bachelor Courses for academic session 2026-27 for the following

- a) **All Government/Private Allied & Healthcare Colleges Affiliated to ABVMU**
 - b) **SGPGIMS, Lucknow**
 - c) **KGMU, Lucknow**
 - d) **UPUMS, Saifai**
1. All admissions in Allied & Healthcare Bachelor Courses in the above Institutions/Universities for the Academic Session 2026-27 will be done only through Counselling, based on the merit of aggregate marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB) in 12th standard examination. For Bachelor of Optometry/B.ASLP the merit of aggregate marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/ Mathematics/ Computer Science/ Statistics/Electronics / Psychology in 12th standard examination aggregate marks will be considered. No direct admission in above institution will be allowed.
 2. **Registration form should be filled through online mode only.**
 3. **No Registration Form shall be received by post or any other means.**
 4. Registration for admission to Allied & Healthcare Bachelor Courses for academic session 2026-27 will be available on University Website www.abvmuup.edu.in from **02th May 2026 (Saturday)**.
 5. Only completely filled and submitted Registration form will be accepted.

Important Information

Registration Fee

1. Candidates from the **Unreserved/Other Backward Classes (UR/OBC)** category will have to pay a Registration fee of **Rs. 750/-** while candidates from **Scheduled Cast/Scheduled Tribe/Persons with Disability (SC/ST/PwD)** category will have to pay a Registration fee of **Rs. 500/-**.
2. The Registration Fee shall be submitted online with the Registration Form.
3. Once the fee has been submitted there shall be no refund of fee and it is non-transferable for any other examination.

Eligibility Criteria

- **Age:** - Minimum age for admission is 17 years on or before 31st December 2026.
- **Minimum qualifications:** -
 1. **Candidate with Science Subjects Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany & Zoology) in 12th Standard examination is eligible for all Allied & Healthcare Bachelor's Courses** provided he/she has obtained a minimum of **50%** marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB) and passed in English individually from any recognized board.
 2. **Candidate with Science Subjects Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics in 12th Standard examination is eligible for the following Allied & Healthcare Bachelor's Courses only –**
 - a. Bachelor of Optometry
 - b. Bachelor in Audiology and Speech Language Pathology

provided that he/she has obtained a minimum of **50%** marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (PCM) and passed in English individually from any recognized board.
 3. **Candidate with Science Subjects Physics, Chemistry, Computer Science/ Statistics/ Electronics/ Psychology in 12th Standard examination is eligible for the following Allied & Healthcare Bachelor's Courses only –**
 - a. **Bachelor in Audiology and Speech Language Pathology**

provided that he/she has obtained a minimum of **50%** marks in Physics, Chemistry and Computer Science/ Statistics/ Electronics/ Psychology and passed in English individually from any recognized board.
 4. In respect of candidates belonging to Schedule Castes, Scheduled Tribes, or Other Backward Classes (NCL), the minimum marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/ Mathematics/ Computer Science/ Statistics/Electronics / Psychology are taken together in the qualifying examination shall be 40% marks instead of 50% marks for Unreserved and General-EWS Candidates. In respect of PwBD/PwD candidates the minimum marks in the qualifying examination in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (or Botany and Zoology) / Mathematics/ Computer Science/ Statistics/Electronics / Psychology taken together shall be 40% instead of 50%. English pass require for all categories.

5. Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by central government having Science subjects and English only.
6. Color Blind candidates are eligible provided that color corrective contact lens and spectacles are worn by such candidates.
7. The selection of candidates will be subject to medical fitness. No selected candidate will be permitted to join the course unless declared medically fit by the Medical Board constituted by the Government Medical College or the District CMO.

Reservation Policy: -

1. Reservation as per the State Government and NCAHP Act reservation policy and within the sanctioned number of seats by State Government and not above it.
2. Any change in reservation policy will be followed as per the Uttar Pradesh State Government directives.
3. Caste Certificates issued **ONLY** by the competent authority (Tehsildar/SDM) of Uttar Pradesh Government are acceptable. **These certificates should be verifiable online through an official Government Portal/Website.**
4. EWS quota of 10% may be admissible as per directives of the U.P. Government from time to time. A valid certificate issued by competent authority (Tehsildar/SDM) of Uttar Pradesh Government shall be required for counselling. **These certificates should be verifiable online through an official Government Portal/Website.**
5. Valid OBC (NCL) certificate issued only on or after 1st April 2026 will be acceptable.
6. Valid EWS certificate issued only on or after 1st April 2026 will be acceptable.
7. Dependent of Freedom Fighter certificate issued from District Magistrate will be acceptable.
8. Valid Ex Servicemen certificate issued from competent authority will be acceptable.
9. Valid NCC certificate “**C certificate with grade B**” issued by authorized battalion on prescribed format for NCC will be acceptable. NCC ‘A’ and ‘B’ Certificates will not be considered for benefit of reservation under this category.

Note: -

- **For admission to Government colleges, the candidate must be a domicile of Uttar Pradesh (Candidate is having the Domicile certificate of Uttar Pradesh issued from a competent authority OR candidate has passed 10th and 12th (10+2) BOTH board Examinations from Uttar Pradesh).**
- **Reservation for Minority and any other category Educational Institution will be as per Govt. of UP norms/directives.**
- **Only Indian citizens are eligible for admission.**

Instructions to Candidates for filling Online Registration Form

- Candidate must carefully read the instructions for filling the online Registration form before proceeding.
- Registration shall be submitted through the online mode only via website www.abvmuup.edu.in
- No Registration form shall be received by post or by any other mode.
- Candidate must ensure that all information provided in the Registration form is correct, if any information is found incorrect or wrong at any stage then the candidature/admission will be cancelled.
- Admission to Allied & Healthcare Bachelor Courses for All Government/Private Allied & Healthcare Colleges Affiliated to ABVMU and SGPGIMS Lucknow, KGMU Lucknow and UPUMS Saifai will be done through Common Allied & Healthcare Undergraduate Admission -2026 only.
- It is hereby informed that if any applicant has provided false information solely for the purpose of obtaining admission, the applicant will be debarred from admission in the future.
- **Candidate should register from personal email id and Mobile number only, as all information/communication will be sent on the registered email address and mobile. They should also not share their Registration No. with any other person for security purposes.**
- **Registered credentials (Email/Mobile) and Registration Id will be used for all communications** and will be required for obtaining the Merit, Counselling details, Allotment Letter and Admission etc.
- Candidate should note their Registration Id & login password.
- University disclaims any liability that may arise to a candidate due to incorrect information provided by him/her in his/her online Registration Form.
- Be extremely careful in filling in the Registration Form. Candidate must check and ensure that all information and details filled by him/her are correct.
- No Change in the Registration will be possible after final submission.
- Incomplete Registrations will be rejected without any further intimation.
- Download the verification proforma before filling the Registration. Take a print out of downloaded PDF in A4 size paper and fill it with a blue ballpoint pen in own handwriting.
- The registration fee once deposited will not be refunded. The fee will not be carried forward to a future registration.
- Registration once submitted cannot be withdrawn. **Candidate must note that mere deduction of fee from the bank account is not proof of fee payment.** The payment should be supported by fee payment receipt.
- A message **“your registration form has been successfully submitted”** will appear on the screen after the final submission of your registration form. Kindly ensure yourself that you receive this message to confirm the final submission of your registration form. Unless the candidate see this message, he/she should not assume final form submission.

Steps for filling Registration Form

Step 1: Candidate Registration

- 1.1 Candidate should visit the official website of the Atal Bihari Vajpayee Medical University, UP- www.abvmuup.edu.in and Click on the Link for **Common Allied & Healthcare Undergraduate Admission 2026**.
- 1.2 Candidate should first register by clicking the **“Register”** button for **Allied & Healthcare Bachelor**.
- 1.3 During the registration process the candidate will have to submit the following information:
 - a) First Name (As per Class 10th Certificate/Marksheet)
 - b) Middle Name
 - c) Last Name
 - d) Father’s Name (As per Class 10th Certificate/Marksheet)
 - e) Mother’s Name (As per Class 10th Certificate/Marksheet)
 - f) Date of Birth (As per Class 10th Certificate/Marksheet)
 - g) Gender
 - h) Email Address (Valid Email for Future Information & Notifications)
 - i) Mobile Number & Alternate Mobile Number (Valid & Active Number for SMS based delivery of Registration Number & Password)
 - j) WhatsApp Number
 - k) Category
 - l) Sub-Category
- 1.4 Candidate should preview the filled information and confirm the same before proceeding to final submission of registration information.
- 1.5 **After confirming the information, the candidate will receive two separate verification OTPs on their registered email & mobile. Candidate has to ensure the correct Mobile OTP and Email OTP are submitted. This is a mandatory step for successful registration of the candidate.**
- 1.6 **One Primary Mobile Number and Email once verified, can be used for a single registration only.**
- 1.7 Upon successful completion of the registration, the candidate will receive his/her Unique Registration Id number & One-Time Login password on their registered mobile number and email address.
- 1.8 Information submitted at this stage will be auto filled in the Personal Information Section (Stage 1) of the Registration form.
- 1.9 **Primary Information submitted during registration cannot be changed or altered at any later stage. The editing in the limited field(s) will be allowed during Form Correction Window.**

IMPORTANT NOTE:

- It is to be noted that the details of the candidate like name, date of birth, gender, mother’s and father’s names in the Registration form must match with class 10th certificate. The Registration Id number is the unique identification for a candidate and must be kept securely and should not be shared with others.
- If a candidate forgets his/her Registration Id number, click on **“Forgot Registration Id Number”** to receive Unique Registration Id number on registered mobile number via a SMS or E-mail.

Step 2: Login & Registration Form Filling

- 2.1 Once the candidate has successfully registered, he/she is required to login into the Registration portal for Registration form filling by clicking the **“Login”** button for **Allied & Healthcare Bachelor**.
- 2.2 For the **first login**, the candidate will be required to submit his/her Unique Registration ID Number and one-time login password which was sent to the email/mobile number at the time of Registration.
- 2.3 Once successfully logged in, it is mandatory for the candidate to change the default password after the first login. Without changing the default password, the candidate will not be able to proceed further with the Registration form filling & fee payment.
- 2.4 If a candidate forgets his/her Password, click on **“Forgot Password”** to receive an OTP on registered mobile number/e-mail to reset the Password.
- 2.5 The Candidates will have to Click on the **“Fill Form”** button to start filling the form.
- 2.6 Candidates should click the **“Save & Next”** button after filling the details at each stage of the Registration form, so that they are able to review, update or edit the Registration at any time prior to final submission.
- 2.7 **Registration Form - Stage 1: Personal Information**

At the first stage of the form, the applicant has to fill personal information. Most of the information on this stage of the Registration form is **pre-filled using the registration data filled by the applicant during the registration stage**.

2.8 Registration Form - Stage 2: Address

- I. In this stage, the candidate must fill his or her Residential details, including Address, State, City and Pin Code.
- II. If the candidate has a different Correspondence address, they can choose to update that or select the option to keep the Residential Details and the Correspondence Address the same

2.9 Registration Form - Stage 3: Educational Qualifications

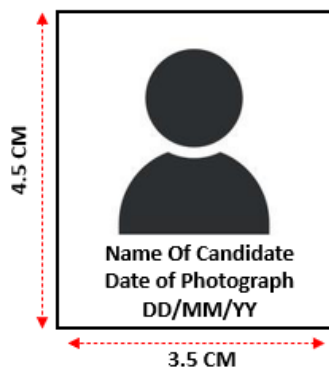
- I. At this stage, the candidate will have to submit the details of his/her educational qualifications as per the Eligibility Notification for each course. These details will include but are not limited to 10th & 12th total marks obtained, total marks, Board/School/College Name etc.
- II. In case the applicant is still awaiting his/her 12th result, he/she has the option to select **“Appearing”** for that particular class. Please note that the candidate would still have to update the marks before merits of Common Allied & Healthcare Undergraduate Admission-2026 are announced. For this, the applicants will be given an opportunity to update his/her marks immediately after the 12th result. Option to update the marks will be given in the Portal.

2.10 Registration Form - Stage 4: Photo and Signature

At this stage the candidate has to upload his/her passport size photo and signature.

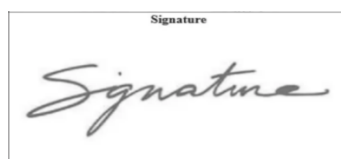
Instructions/Guidelines for uploading passport size Photograph

- The photograph should be full face, from front, with white background and without spectacles.
- Both ears should be visible.
- The name of the candidate and the date of photograph (DD/MM/YY) taken should be placed on the photograph (sample given below).
- The format (.jpg) should be between (50-200KB size).
- The image dimensions should be passport 4.5 X 3.5 cm.
- The candidate must not wear any glasses.
- The candidate must not wear a hat/cap on his/her head.



Instructions/Guidelines for uploading Signature:

- In running handwriting with a black ball point pen.
- Signature should be on a white paper with no linings.
- The Image should be in (.jpg) format and size should be (50-200KB size).
- Signature done in CAPITAL letters is not acceptable.
- Signature image should be scanned or photographed for uploading.
- Overwriting in signature is prohibited.



Note: If at any stage it is found that the signature or photograph has been forged, the case will be considered as 'Unfair Means Practices' and action will be taken accordingly.

2.11 Registration Form - Stage 5: Form Preview

- I. After filling all the necessary details – the candidate should click on form preview and verify all details before moving to the next step for Registration payment submission.
- II. The next step of the online Registration form is to check the Declaration Box to declare that the information submitted is true and correct. Once the declaration is agreed upon by checking the box [✓] the candidate has to click on “**Save & Pay Fee**” button.

Step 3: Fee submission

- 3.1 Once the candidate has successfully finished filling their Registration form on the **Common Allied & Healthcare Undergraduate Admission -2026**, click on “**Pay Fee for Allied & Healthcare Bachelor**” button to pay the mandatory registration fee.
- 3.2 On clicking the “**Pay Fee for Allied & Healthcare Bachelor**” button, the candidate will be redirected to an Online Payment Gateway to pay the Registration Fee Online via a Debit Card/ Credit Card/ Net Banking or UPI.
 - a) **In case of payment failure, the candidate can attempt the payment again. Candidate should attempt for fresh payment only-after receiving message of unsuccessful attempt of last payment done or**
In case if no message is received, candidate should wait for 30 minutes before making any further payment.
 - b) **IMPORTANT: IN CASE OF MULTIPLE PAYMENTS AT THE TIME OF FEE SUBMISSION, THE REFUND WILL BE DONE TO THE SOURCE FROM WHERE THE PAYMENT WAS ORIGINALLY MADE.**
 - c) The latest successful payment will be considered for filling the Registration form and any old payments will be refunded to the source.
 - d) Candidate will receive a payment receipt upon a successful payment confirmation on the portal in candidate login.

Step 4: Final form submission

- 4.1 After the successful payment confirmation through the portal, the Registration form will be automatically submitted and a confirmation message will be shown on the portal.
- 4.2 A message “**your registration form has been successfully submitted**” will appear on the screen after the final submission of your registration form. Kindly ensure yourself that you receive this message to confirm the final submission of your registration form. Unless the candidate see this message, he/she should not assume final form submission.
- 4.3 After successful final submission of the Registration form, a confirmation email will be sent to the candidate on his/her registered email.
- 4.4 The candidate will be able to download the final submitted Registration form by clicking on **Print** Button form after the successful submission of registration fee.

Merit

- a) Date of Declaration of merits **will be announced on the** official website of **Atal Bihari Vajpayee Medical University, Lucknow (www.abvmuup.edu.in)**
- b) The merit list will be prepared on the basis of aggregate marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB) in 12th standard examination. A combined merit list and category wise merit list will be prepared. For Bachelor of Optometry/B.ASLP the merit of aggregate marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/ Mathematics/ Computer Science/ Statistics/Electronics / Psychology in 12th standard examination aggregate marks will be considered.
- c) **The inter-se-merit of candidates for tie-breaking:**
In case of two or more candidates obtain equal marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB) / Mathematics/ Computer Science/ Statistics/Electronics / Psychology in 12th standard examination the inter-se-merit shall be determined as follows:
 1. Candidate obtaining higher marks in Biology (Botany & Zoology)/Mathematics/Computer Science/Electronics/ Statistics/Psychology in the 12th standard examination, followed by,
 2. Candidate obtaining higher marks in Chemistry in the 12th standard examination, followed by,
 3. Candidate obtaining higher marks in Physics in the 12th standard examination, followed by,
 4. Candidate obtaining higher marks in English
 5. Higher Age (Older)
 6. High School (Class 10th) examination marks percentage

Counselling Procedure:

Details for counselling will be available on the University Website after declaration of merit.

Admission:

- a. The selection and allotment of college shall be strictly done on the basis of merit through Counselling only.
- b. The candidate, who has qualified for the admission to the Allied & Healthcare Bachelor course, shall deposit the prescribed fee on the date notified for that purpose by the University. Those who fail to do so will lose their claim for admission to the course.
- c. Candidates shall join the course within the specified period.

Important Note:

- In case of any dispute, the decision of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, ABVMU, UP, Lucknow shall be final.
- In case of any legal dispute the jurisdiction will be Lucknow Courts and Judicature of Allahabad High Court, Lucknow Bench only.
- In case of any discrepancy in Information Bulletin, the English version will be considered to be final.

Method of Normalization of Marks Across Different Boards for the Admission Process

The method involves Z-score normalization, which standardizes individual marks based on the mean and standard deviation of the respective board.

The rescaling process involves the following method:

Each student's raw score (X_{ij}) is converted into a normalized score (S_{ij}) using:

$$S_{ij} = \mu + [(X_{ij} - \mu_i) / \sigma_i] \times \sigma$$

where μ_i is the mean and σ_i is the standard deviation of marks of j^{th} candidate for the i^{th} board. The μ and σ are the maximum mean of the raw scores and standard deviation of the raw scores having maximum mean, respectively, which are taken as reference mean and reference standard deviation. Through this method, students are evaluated based on their relative performance within their board, rather than absolute marks.

6. Color Blind candidates are eligible provided that color corrective contact lens and spectacles are worn by such candidates.
7. The selection of candidates will be subject to medical fitness. No selected candidate will be permitted to join the course unless declared medically fit by the Medical Board constituted by the Government Medical College or the District CMO.

IMPOTANT INFORMATION

1. The eligible candidates will have to register themselves on the online portal for Counselling and seat allocation.
2. Online Registration for Counselling is to be done by candidate through the official website www.abvmuup.edu.in.
3. Candidate should register for Counselling on the portal using their **Common Allied & Healthcare Undergraduate Admission -2026 Registration ID and Password (Same as used for filling the Application form)**.
4. Candidate has to pay INR 500/- as Counselling Registration Fee (**NON-Refundable**) and INR 5,000/- as Counselling Security Fee through online mode. The candidates who do not pay both fees will not be considered for Counselling process.
5. After the Completion of all rounds of Counselling, the **admitted candidates** and those candidates who have **not been allotted** any seat will be refunded Counselling Security fee (INR 5,000/-) **at the source account from which the payment was made**.
6. After seat allotment the candidate has to pay a **Seat Confirmation Fee of INR 40,000/-** (Rs. Forty thousand only) through online mode/challan method to ABVMU, UP to confirm seat allotment. This amount will be transferred to the allotted college and adjusted against tuition fee after completion of all rounds of Counselling process.
7. After seat allotment, the candidate has to report in person to the allotted college for document verification and to complete the admission process. **Failing to report to the allotted college within the specified date and time will lead to forfeit of Counselling security fee (INR 5,000/-)**. It is the responsibility of the candidate to carry the original certificates and one (01) set of Self-attested photocopy of Documents/Certificates for verification purpose. All admissions are provisional and can be cancelled at any time if any information is found to be wrong.
8. **After admission in the college if candidate does not resign from the seat during the resignation window i.e. from 30-07-2026 to 03-08-2026 up to 6.00 pm, his/her Seat confirmation fee Rs. 40,000/- and counseling security fee Rs. 5,000/- will be forfeited.**
9. **After the seat allotment and acceptance in Mop up round, if any candidate is not taking admission in allotted college till the last date of reporting in the college, the allotted seat and security fee (INR 5,000/-) and Seat Confirmation Fee of INR 40,000/- will be forfeited.**
10. **Original certificates and other fees are to be submitted ONLY at the start of the academic session .**
11. **At the time of document verification at the allotted college, the candidate should present all original and valid certificates/documents. Failure to do so will lead to cancellation of allotted seat.**

12. Candidates must be medically fit for persuasion of the course. The candidates who are issued provisional seat allotment letter are required to submit certificate of medical fitness issued by Government Medical College/District Hospital/District CMO.
13. **For admission to Government Allied & Healthcare Colleges, the candidate must be a domicile of Uttar Pradesh only. (Candidate is having the Domicile certificate of Uttar Pradesh issued from a competent authority or Candidate has passed Class 10th and 12th intermediate (10+2) BOTH board Examinations from Uttar Pradesh).**
For Private Colleges student are eligible from other states also.
14. **The selection of the candidates will be strictly based on the merit list and preference of the college given by the candidate.**
15. **No Direct Admission by any college will be permitted.**
16. Candidates are advised not to wait for last date and time to register and exercise options of seat/college choice to avoid last minute inconvenience.
17. **Candidates registered for Counselling have to fill their choices according to their preferences.**
They are advised to fill as many choices as they want to increase the possibility of seat allotment for admission.
18. The decision of the Counselling Committee, ABVMU, UP shall be final in the matter of selection of candidates for admission to the course and no appeal shall be entertained regarding this.
19. **In case of any legal dispute the jurisdiction will be at Judicature of Allahabad High Court at its Lucknow Bench only.**
20. **In case of any discrepancy in Counselling Bulletin, the English version will be considered to be final.**

Reservation Policy: -

1. Reservation as per the State Government and NCAHP Act reservation policy and within the sanctioned number of seats by State Government and not above it.
2. Any change in reservation policy will be followed as per the Uttar Pradesh State Government directives.
3. Reservation for disability (PwD): 5% Horizontal reservation will be considered for disabled candidates with **a disability of loco-motor to the tune of 40% to 50% of the lower extremity** and other eligibility criteria with regard to qualification will be same as prescribed for Unreserved (UR) category candidates. (The Gazette of India No. 275 dated 05th July 2021).

NOTE: PwD candidates taking admission has to be examined by a medical examination board constituted by the Government Medical Colleges/ Institutions for verification of the disability of loco-motor to the tune of 40-50% of lower limb.

4. Caste Certificates issued **ONLY** by the competent authority (Tehsildar/SDM) of Uttar Pradesh Government are acceptable. **These certificates should be verifiable online through an official Government Portal/Website.**

5. EWS quota of 10% may be admissible as per directives of the U.P. Government from time to time. A valid certificate issued by competent authority (Tehsildar/SDM) of Uttar Pradesh Government shall be required for Counselling. **These certificates should be verifiable online through an official Government Portal/Website.**
6. Valid OBC Non creamy layer certificate issued only on or after 1st April 2026 will be acceptable.
7. Valid EWS certificate issued only on or after 1st April 2026 will be acceptable.
8. Dependent of Freedom Fighter certificate issued from District Magistrate will be acceptable.
9. Valid Ex Servicemen certificate issued from competent authority will be acceptable.
10. Valid NCC certificate “**C certificate with grade B**” issued by authorized battalion on prescribed format for NCC will be acceptable. **NCC ‘A’ and ‘B’ Certificates will not be considered for benefit of reservation under this category.**

Note: -

- **For admission to Government Colleges, the candidate must be a domicile of Uttar Pradesh (Candidate is having the Domicile certificate of Uttar Pradesh issued from a competent authority or candidate has passed 10th and 12th (10+2) BOTH board Examinations from Uttar Pradesh).**
- **Reservation for Minority and any other category Educational Institution will be as per Govt. of UP norms/ directives.**
- **Only Indian citizens are eligible for admission.**

ROUND 1

Eligibility

All the candidates who have been listed as Qualified for Counselling in the result notification will be able to participate in the Counselling subject to fulfilling the eligibility criteria as prescribed in Information Bulletin.

Registration Process

Online Registration for Counselling will be done by candidate through the official **Common Allied & Healthcare Undergraduate Admission -2026** website -www.abvmuup.edu.in. The registration process is as follows:

1. Eligible candidates will be able to register for Counselling through their existing login (**Same as used at the time of filling the Application form**). To login to the portal candidates should visit www.abvmuup.edu.in and login using their **Common Allied & Healthcare Undergraduate Admission -2026 Registration ID and Password**.
2. During registration, all primary information like Candidate Name, Father's Name, Mother's Name & Date of Birth (DOB), Category, Sub-category and Address will be automatically pre-filled as submitted by the candidate during **Common Allied & Healthcare Undergraduate Admission -2026** registration.
3. Candidates who had marked **Appearing** in 12th Standard examination (10+2) board examination during the **application process have to update the (10+2) marks**.
4. Candidates will also have to upload the
 - a. High school certificate (Class 10th) and
 - b. 12th Standard examination (10+2) Intermediate mark sheet/ statement of marks.
5. Candidates will have to update their Domicile status Uttar Pradesh state (Yes/No), Minority status (Christian/Jain/Muslim/Not Applicable) details and upload the certificates for
 - a. Domicile status (if applicable)
 - b. Minority status (if applicable)
 - c. Category and/or Sub-Category certificate (if applicable).
6. Candidate can also update their **Gender information if filled wrong in the form** at the time of filling the application form.
7. Candidate can update his/her Category (Present Category to UR only and Sub Category to Category only).
8. The candidate will have to deposit
 - a. INR 500/- as Counselling Registration Fee online (**Non-Refundable**) and
 - b. INR 5,000/- as Counselling Security Fee

Both fee will be deposited online through a single payment of INR 5500 (INR 500 + INR 5,000).
9. After the successful registration candidate can proceed to the next step of selecting colleges as per their choice and save it.

Exercising of choices, Acceptance of Seat Allocation and Admission Process

1. The online seat allocation portal will allow the candidate to make choices of colleges along with courses and arrange them in desired order of preference. The candidate can make any number of choices and can edit and re-order the preferences within the Date and Time specified in schedule. **They are advised to fill as many choices as he/she wish to avoid rejection in seat allotment.**
2. The Counselling Portal will be opened for dates as per schedule. **The choices made by the candidate should be saved by the candidate before log out.** Candidates can make changes in the saved preferences/choices as many times as he/she wish. The preferred choices will be automatically locked on the last Date and Time specified in the schedule.
3. Candidates should take a printout of their college choices after locking of college choices on the last Date and Time specified in the schedule.
4. The seat allotment to the candidates will be done strictly in order of **Common Allied & Healthcare Undergraduate Admission -2026** merit and according to choices made by the candidates as locked.
5. The candidates should login to the portal for information regarding seat allotment on 20-07-2026.
6. All the candidates who have been allocated seats in the Round 1 are required to login to the portal and choose any one of the following options within Date and Time specified in the schedule:

Option1 ACCEPT allotted seat (Freeze)

Option2 DECLINE allotted seat (Decline).

Important Note:

Failure to login and selecting an option after seat allocation within the Date and Time specified in the schedule will lead to forfeiture of the allotted seat and Counselling security fee (INR 5,000/-)

7. All the candidates who are allocated seats and exercised Option 1 are **mandatorily** required to deposit **Seat Confirmation Fee** of INR 40,000/- (Rupees Forty thousand only) to ABVMU UP through online/challan mode. This amount will be transferred to the allotted college and adjusted against tuition fee after completion of all rounds of Counselling process.
8. After depositing seat confirmation fee, Candidate selecting the **Option 1 (Freeze)** is required to **report in-person** to allocated college for completing the admission process within the Date and Time specified in the schedule.
9. The candidates are required to carry the **original certificates along with** one (01) set of Self-attested photocopy of Documents/Certificates at the time of reporting to the allotted college.
10. The college will verify all the documents and update the same through College Portal. If all eligibility criteria are fulfilled and verified, a duly signed **provisional admission letter will be provided to the candidate by the College.**

NOTE: Original certificates and other fees are to be submitted ONLY at the start of the academic session.

12. **After the seat allotment and acceptance, if any candidate does not report to the College, his/her allotted seat will be Cancelled and Counselling Security Fee (INR 5,000/-) will be forfeited.**
13. **After admission in the college if candidate does not resign from the seat during the resignation window i.e. from 30-07-2026 to 03-08-2026 up to 6.00 pm., the Counseling security fee (INR 5,000/-) and the Seat Confirmation fee (INR 40,000/-) will be forfeited.**
14. **The candidates who have not been allotted any seat in Round 1 of Counselling will be eligible for Mop up Round of Counselling without paying the Counselling security fee of (INR 5,000/-). However, candidate has to pay Counselling registration fee of INR 500/- .**

Mop up Round

Eligibility

Following candidates will be eligible to participate in Mop up Round of Counselling

- All candidates who have not participated in Round 1 of Counselling.
- All candidates who have participated in Round 1 and have not been allotted any college seat.
- **All candidates who have completed the admission process in Round 1 can also participate in the Mop up Round but they have to resign from their allotted seat within the specified Date and Time before registration. After resignation he/she will not have any claim on the previously allotted seat. The allotted seat and security fee INR 5,000/- will be forfeited.**

Following candidates will not be eligible to participate in Mop up Round of Counselling

- All candidates who have participated and allotted seat in Round 1 and have not resigned.

Registration Process

Online Registration for Counselling will be done by candidate through the official **Common Allied & Healthcare Undergraduate Admission -2026** website- www.abvmuup.edu.in. The registration process is as follows:

1. Eligible candidates will be able to register for Counselling through their existing login. To login to the portal candidates should visit www.abvmuup.edu.in and login using their **Common Allied & Healthcare Undergraduate Admission -2026 Registration ID and Password**.
2. All the candidates participating will have to deposit INR 500/- as Counselling Registration Fee (Non-Refundable), except those who have registered in Round 1 and have not been allotted any seat.

3. Following steps to be completed by candidates who have participated in Round 1 of Counselling

10. Candidates who have participated in Round 1 are required to deposit security fee of INR 5,000/- **except;**
 - Candidates who have registered for Round 1 Counselling and have not been allotted any seat.

Exercising of choices, Acceptance of Seat allocation and Admission Process

1. The Counselling Portal will be opened for dates as per schedule. **The choices made by the candidate should be saved by the candidate before log out.** Candidates can make changes in the saved preferences/choices as many times as he/she wish. The preferred choices will be automatically locked on the last Date and Time specified in the schedule.
2. Candidates should take a printout of their college choices after locking of college choices on the last Date and Time specified in the schedule.
3. The seat allocation will be done strictly in order of **Common Allied & Healthcare Undergraduate Admission -2026** merit and according to choices made by the candidates as locked.
4. All the candidates who have been allocated seats in the Mop up Round are required to login to the portal and choose any one of the following options within Date and Time specified in the schedule:
Option 1. ACCEPT allotted seat.
Option 2. DECLINE allotted seat.

Important Note: Failure to login and selecting an option after seat allocation within the Date and Time specified in the schedule will lead to forfeiture of the allotted seat and security fee (INR 5,000/-)

5. All the candidates who are allocated seats and exercised Option 1 are **mandatorily** required to deposit seat confirmation fee of INR 40,000/- (Rupees Forty thousand only) to ABVMU UP through online/challan transfer, which will be transferred to the allotted college and adjusted against tuition fee after completion of Counselling process (Candidates who have already deposited INR 40,000/- in Round 1 are not required to re-deposit).
6. After depositing seat confirmation fee, Candidate is required to **report in-person** to allocated college for admission process within the Date and Time specified in the schedule.

7. The candidates are required to carry the **original certificates along with** one (01) set of Self-attested photocopy of Documents/Certificates at the time of reporting to the allotted college.
8. The college will verify all the documents and update the same through College Portal. If all eligibility criteria are fulfilled and verified, a duly signed **provisional admission letter will be provided to the candidate by the College.**

Note: After the seat allotment and acceptance in Mop up Round, if any candidate is not taking admission in allotted college till the last date of reporting in the college, the allotted seat, Counselling security fee (INR 5,000/-) and Seat Confirmation Fee of INR 40,000/- will be forfeited.

The Seat Conversion

The conversion of seats will be carried out after the Mop up Round of seat allotment. The said conversion will be done, only when the qualified candidates belonging to the said conversion category/sub-category have exhausted. The algorithm for conversion of categories/ sub-categories is as per following table:
