

Blood transfusion is an important treatment for both acute and long-term complications of SCD. In the acute setting (e.g. ACS, acute stroke, acute anaemia, acute multi-organ failure) it can be life-saving and should proceed with minimum delay. There are numerous beneficial effects of blood transfusion including correction of anaemia, improved oxygen carrying capacity and reversal of acute sickling complications. These benefits should be balanced against its side-effects which include infection, alloimmunisation and hyperhaemolyis.
