30 January, 2024



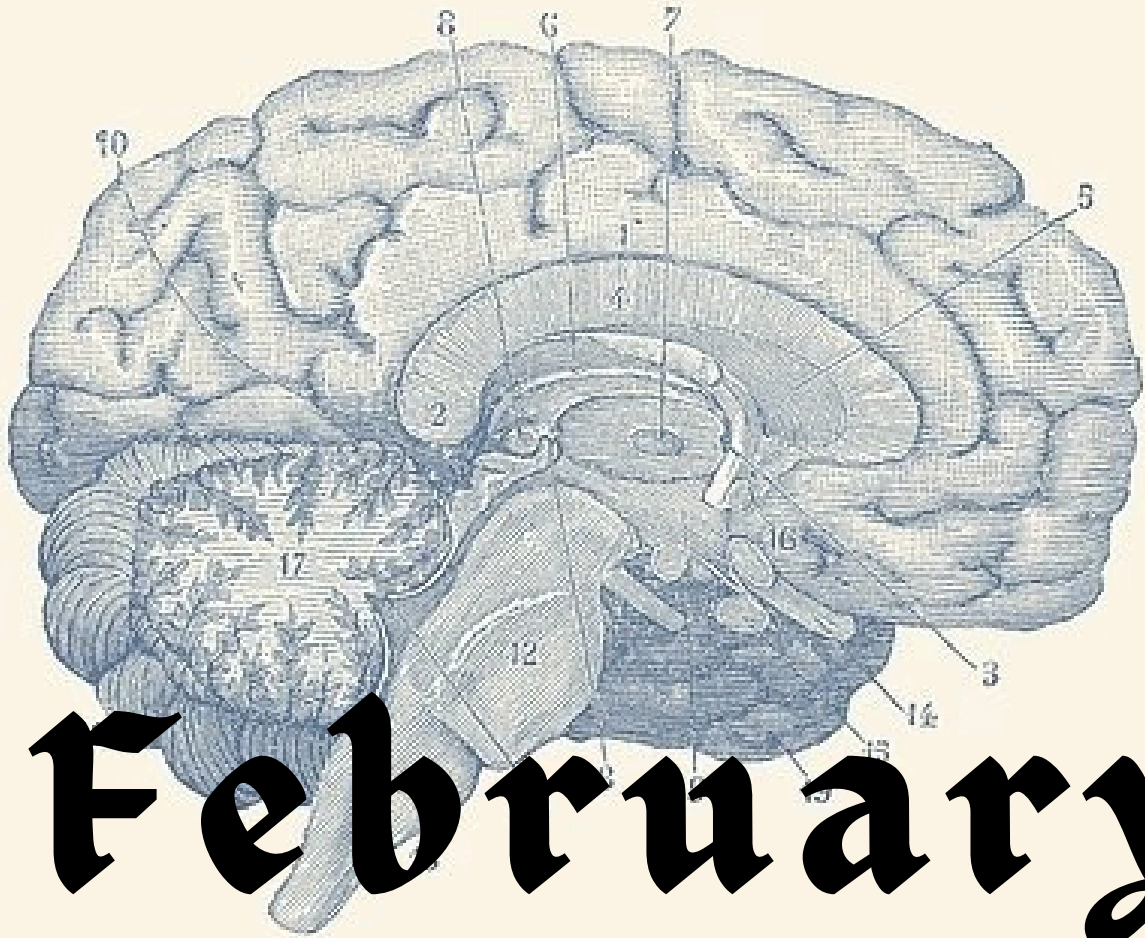

Social Security Scheme Camp

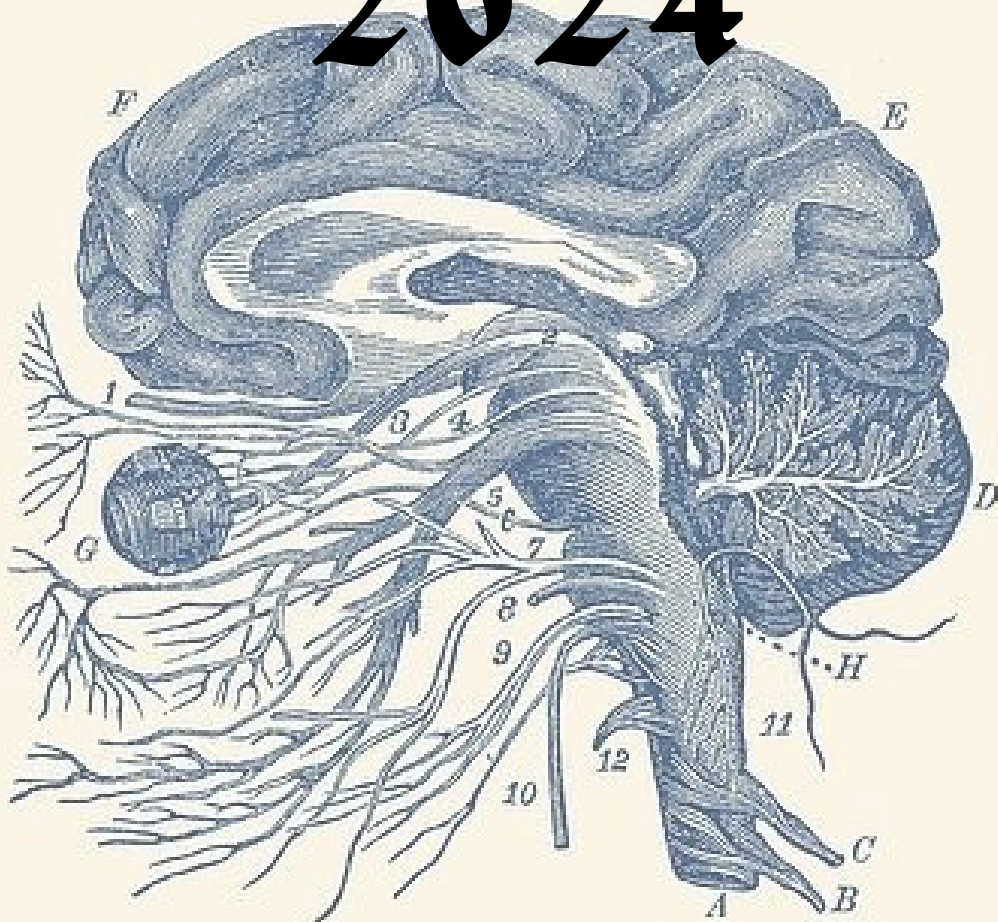
30 January, 2024

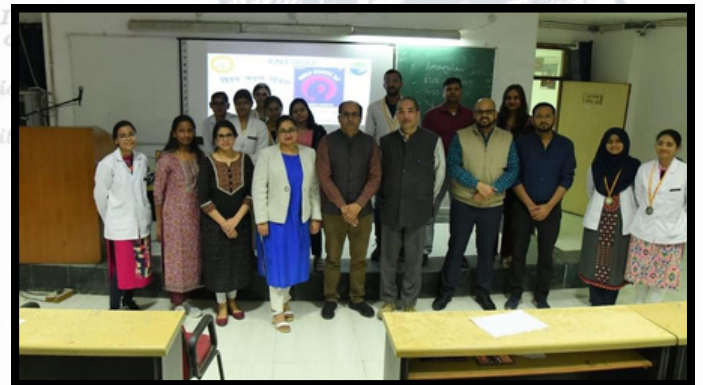
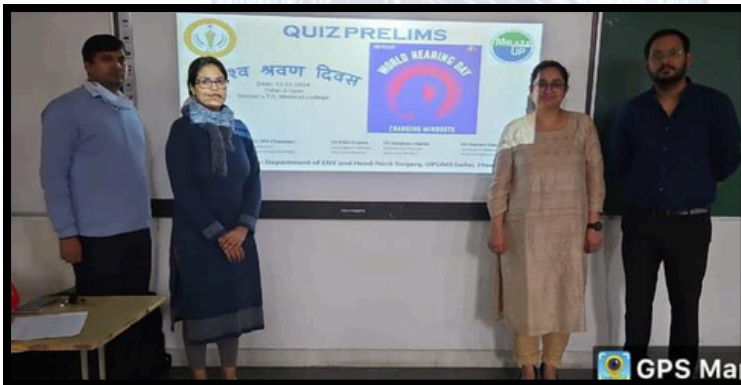

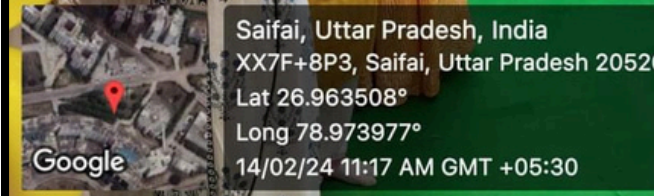
Celebration Of Basant Panchami
